*Note: "Big Field" above Newquay was used for flying between the wars. It was swallowed up by RAF Trebelzue which in turn was swallowed up by RAF St Mawgan (which was originally a little to the East of Trebelzue). Post War RAF St Mawgan took on a "double life" as Newquay airport. The Airfield itself is now completely civilian run.*
